**Summary:** The purpose of this DOT Dash is to highlight recent changes made to the pre-requisite requirements for CON 353.


Effective October 1, 2010, prior to registering for CON 353 students must have gained one (1) year of experience in either Contracting (CON) or Industrial/Contract Property Management (IND) after being certified Level II in CON or IND.

This means you must have one year of experience in either contracting or industrial/contract property management from the date of your Level II certification **before** you will be permitted to register for CON 353.
