SUBJECT: July 2008 Civil Reserve Air Fleet (CRAF) Allocation

The Alaska section consists of 4 cargo aircraft. The Domestic Services section consists of 36 aircraft. The Short-Range International section consists of 17 cargo and 245 passenger aircraft. The Aeromedical Evacuation segment consists of 50 aircraft. The Long-Range International section consists of 314 cargo and 583 passenger aircraft. Total CRAF aircraft is 1,253.
